

B-F2019-05: To require prospective student organization advisors to receive Responsible Employee training prior to the official Student Government recognition process.

A Bill,

To require that all advisors for prospective student organizations receive Responsible Employee training under the Title IX Office before the organization can present to the Governmental Affairs Committee. The Title IX Office definition of Responsible Employees states “Responsible Employees have a duty to report to the Title IX Office all relevant details of any alleged sexual violence, dating violence, stalking, or sexual harassment incident involving a TCNJ community member about which the Responsible Employees knows or should reasonably be aware.¹” This is to ensure that advisors are better equipped in their role and will streamline the training process for prospective student organizations, should they be recognized.

Bylaw 03, Section A, Subsection 4

Details

Bylaw 03, Section A, Subsection 4 shall be amended.

Bylaw 03, Section A, Subsection 4 shall read:

The prospective organization must have an advisor who is a TCNJ faculty member or staff member. Any prospective advisor must receive Responsible Employee training under the Title IX Office before the prospective organization can present to the Governmental Affairs Committee. If the advisor has previously received Responsible Employee training, it must be no more than three years prior to the start of the recognition process. If the training occurred more than three years prior to the recognition process, the advisor must receive Responsible Employee training again.

Bylaw 03, Section A, Subsection 4 shall be instilled.
