Student Government members, guests, and attendees are not required to dress in business professional attire and may differ to dressing to their own level of comfortability at general body meetings. During elections informationals and other general advertisements of Student Government meetings it will be stated that attendees and members should dress as they please. At Student Government retreats members will not be given any specific instruction on how to dress at meetings. Clubs and special guests will be informed to dress to their own comfortability as well. Student Government members and attendees will not be discriminated against in any way based off of their choice of attire.
